## **ON-CAMPUS PROGRAM (COMPULSORY):**

Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> of May - Friday the 21<sup>st</sup> of June 2024

Earliest arrival date - Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup>

Accommodation will be available from May 25<sup>th</sup>, you will be picked up from your arrival place in Toulouse (airport or train station) and taken to your individual apartment in a residence.

## INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (OPTIONAL):

## Monday the 24<sup>th</sup> of June – Friday the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2024

Students will be allowed to leave Toulouse on Friday, **July 19<sup>th</sup>** evening from 6:00 pm after the on-campus oral presentation of their internship (or the following day, Saturday, **July 20<sup>th</sup>**, Friday night accommodation in a residence hall is covered).
