Practical information

ON-CAMPUS PROGRAM (COMPULSORY):

Monday the 27th of May - Friday the 21st of June 2024

Earliest arrival date - Saturday, **May 25th**

Accommodation will be available from May 25th, you will be picked up from your arrival place in Toulouse (airport or train station) and taken to your individual apartment in a residence.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (OPTIONAL):

Monday the 24th of June – Friday the 19th of July 2024

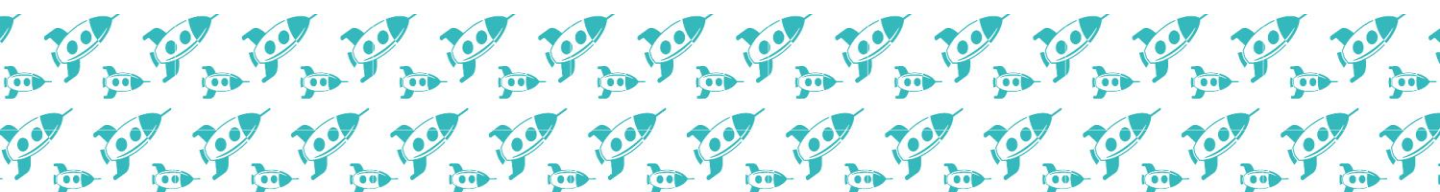
Students will be allowed to leave Toulouse on Friday, **July 19th** evening from 6:00 pm after the on-campus oral presentation of their internship (or the following day, Saturday, **July 20th**, Friday night accommodation in a residence hall is covered).

STUDY TOUR (OPTIONAL):

Monday the 24th of June – Friday the 5th of July 2024

Students will be allowed to leave Toulouse on Friday, **July 5th** from 6.00 pm.

If students do not enroll neither in the internship nor in the study tour option, they will be allowed to leave Toulouse on Saturday, **June 22nd**

PROGRAM OFFER

Practical information

ON-CAMPUS PROGRAM (COMPULSORY) (9 European credits)

4-week intensive course in English, with field visits

- **Week 1:** European Culture & Agricultural Economics (1,5 ECTS)
- **Week 2:** European Animal Production & Economics (1,5 ECTS)
- **Weeks 3 & 4:** Food Option (3 ECTS)
OR
- **Weeks 3 & 4:** Viticulture & Enology option (3 ECTS)

French courses (3 ECTS)

Cultural visits of Toulouse & week-end excursions (Pyrenees mountains, Barcelona)

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (3 European credits)

4-week placement, in July, on a farm, or within an agri-related business (examples: vineyard, cattle farm, cheese making farm...)

Immersion within a family, English speaking or not, also interested in the cultural exchange; activities together or free during week-ends

Take part in the everyday tasks on the farm: hands-on experience according to knowledge & experience

follows the on-campus program, cannot be taken separately

STUDY TOUR OPTION focused on quality labels (4 European credits)

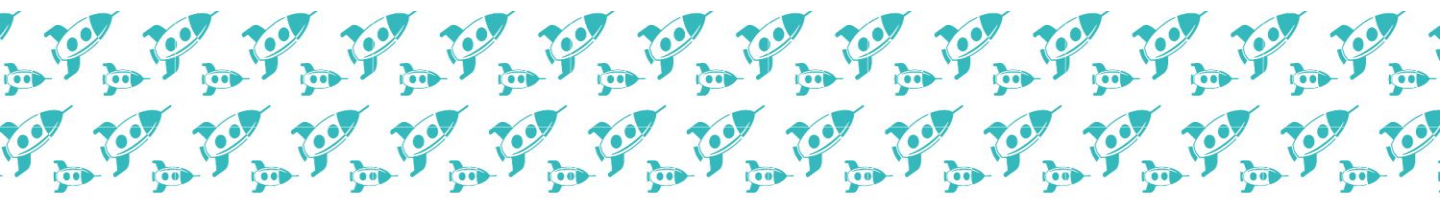
1st week: Focus on PLANT PRODUCTION

- Wine cooperative and vineyard under the appellation “Monbazillac”
- Walnut operation and traditional walnut oil processing plant- “Noix du Périgord”
- CIREF (Experimental Center on strawberries) and a Strawberry farm – “Fraise du Périgord”
- Truffle farm

2nd week: Focus on ANIMAL PRODUCTION

- Esturgeon farming at Domaine Huso where “Caviar de Neuvic” is produced
- Geese and ducks traditional breeding farm to produce livers “Foie-gras du Périgord”
- Lamb production farm “Agneau du Périgord”
- Milk-fed veal operation “Veau du Périgord”

On-Campus Program fee includes:
